- All students must report to school at the regular time **7:50 a.m. in the morning on their examination days** and will leave school premises after the exam from **8/9/25 to 20/9/25** at 12pm.
- It is mandatory for all students to appear for the Half Yearly Examinations and the marks obtained will be a part of the annual average result at the end of the academic session.
- The answer sheets will be provided by the school for writing the exams.
- In case of medical leave, a formal medical certificate must be submitted in school on the same day as the exam missed (or the following day in case of emergency)
